Q: Can solar be built on a landfill?

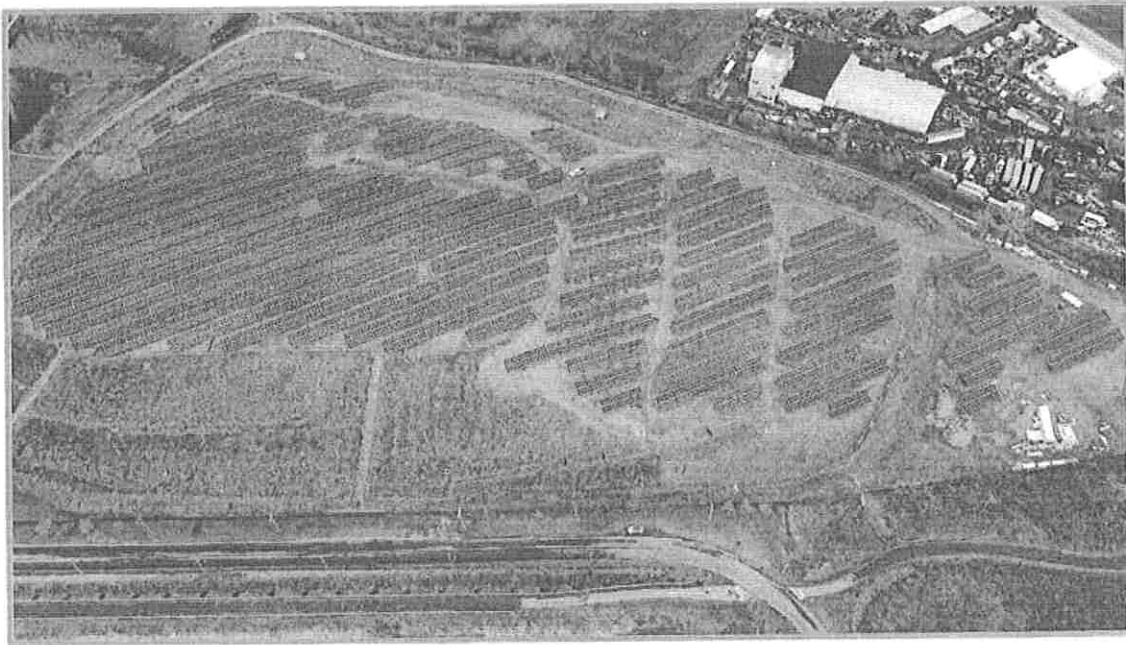
A: Yes. We use non-invasive, ballasted systems that sit on top of the landfill cap without disturbing it.
