K-9 TRANSFER/LIABILITY RELEASE

The following is meant to serve as documentation for the purchase and ownership transfer of a Police Service Dog.

The Village of Medina, is the owner of the property consisting of a Police Service Dog. This Police Service Dog will be referenced here in as K-9 Phoenix.

A Police K-9 is a unique property, and disposing of this property is a matter that requires a specific set of circumstances. As such, the Village of Medina Board hereby declares the K-9 Phoenix as surplus and agrees to transfer ownership of this property under the following terms.

The Village of Medina agrees to sell and transfer full ownership of K-9 Phoenix to the following Buyer, Jacob Reeves, for the sum of \$1.00. This transfer of ownership would be to this individual only, and the transfer is contingent upon the Buyer agreeing not to resell the dog, or use or allow the canine to be used in the manner it was used for by the Village for any reason.

By entering into this agreement, the Buyer agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Village of Medina, Chief of Police, and previous Canine Handlers and Trainers of any expense and or liability surrounding the actions or ownership of K-9 Phoenix. The Buyer will be solely liable for the care and liable for any damages that may result from the care and ownership of the K-9.
