**WHEREAS**, the Village of Medina has applied for and subsequently received notice of award of an engineering planning grant; and,

**WHEREAS**, implementation of the planning grant will address questions about the cost, scope and impacts of potential wastewater collection system or other wastewater facilities improvements being considered in the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Medina must provide a minimum local match of \$6,000 to enjoy benefit of the maximum grant award of \$30,000 from the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village Mayor is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents and instruments necessary to bring about the Project and to fulfill the Village of Medina's obligations under the Engineering Planning Grant; and

**NOW, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village of Medina authorizes and appropriates a minimum of 20% local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program for the Village of Medina Inflow and Infiltration Improvements Study Project. Under the Engineering Planning Grant Program, this local match must be at least 20% of the grant award. The maximum local share appropriated subject to any changes agreed to by the Mayor of the Village of Medina shall not exceed \$6,000 based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of \$36,000. The Mayor of the Village of Medina may increase this local match through the use of in-kind services without further approval from the Village of Medina.

A motion was made by Trustee Bensley and seconded by Trustee Sherman. The Mayor is authorized to sign an agreement with Wendel for professional services regarding the Engineering Planning Grant received, to provide a Sewer System Capacity Study, for a fee of \$24,000.
