The Mayor opened the Public Hearing regarding the Community Development Block Grant for the Takeform Project. Mayor Sidari recognized Gabrielle Barone from the Orleans Economic Development Agency. Ms. Barone explained the purpose of the grant, which was to fund machinery and equipment needed for the recent expansion of the business. She noted that an additional 53 jobs had been created. The Mayor closed the Public Hearing at 7:06 p.m. when no interested persons appeared to speak.

A portion of Bernz O Matic Drive, located within the Village of Medina and the Town of Shelby, beginning in the northwest corner of the intersection of the right-of-way of Bernz O Matic Drive with the Town border of Ridgeway and Shelby, and then heading south approximately 440 feet, then at a right angle westerly approximately 62 feet, then at a right angle northerly approximately 439 feet to the boundary between the Towns of Ridgeway and Shelby, then at an approximate 90 degree angle, 65 feet easterly to the point of beginning. Said parcel is approximately .6 acres and contains a section of Bernz O Matic Drive and its right-of-way surrounded on three (3) sides by property owned by B360 Holdings LLC.

Perry reported that this department had installed a water line at the Industrial Park to service the Cobblestone Hotel and were getting the Village roads ready for paving in the next couple of weeks. He also reported that 4 RBC's were installed and operating at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Supt. Perry requested approval to hire an individual for the Laborer position. The matter was tabled for review.

Trustee Bensley asked Supt. Perry to fill in some potholes in the Boxwood Cemetery at the entrance to Glenwood Lake.

Attorney Brooks reported that a Notice of Claim had been received regarding a dog bite case.
